

The Poudre School District Board of Education met for its business meeting on March 10, 2026 at the Johannsen Support Services Center. The agenda for this meeting included:

Board recognitions and resolutions

The Board began its meeting by approving a resolution to [recognize March as Women's History Month](#), presented by a senior from Fossil Ridge High School.

Board members also [recognized the Poudre Fire Authority](#) for its continued partnership with the district in teaching students important life skills, including CPR, AED, and stop the bleed training.

Superintendent report

During his [superintendent report](#), Brian Kingsley remarked that there is new student artwork hung in the boardroom and lobby of the JSSC, noting that student artists will be recognized in April at the Super Art Exhibition.

He also commented that, over the last two weeks, he visited 7 different schools across the district and elevated two of them: Bamford Elementary School and Bacon Elementary School for the strong and supportive engagement between staff and students that he witnessed during his visits.

Kingsley also played a [video](#) that summarizes the district's current situation regarding enrollment and what the [Comprehensive Planning Committee](#) has been charged with.

Informal Reports / Discussion items

The Board passed three different action items during the meeting on various topics. These include:

- A unanimous approval of 10-year contracts for K-5 mathematics, Spanish, and German curriculums
- A 4-3 passing of a refresh to front of classroom technology
- A 6-1 passing of a renewal of district firewall services

The board also heard two reports from district employees. The first was from Integrated Services Director Dr. Jodie Rommel who reviewed the Child Find process, providing information about how PSD serves students supported by an IEP and information about the Integrated Services program.

Board members also heard an update from Executive Director of Communications John Cope regarding the Choose PSD marketing campaign. The presentation explored the reach of the campaign and its impact to date.
