



JC - SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

~~Attendance areas for each District school shall be recommended by the superintendent and/or a committee formed to review school attendance areas and approved by the Board. A student's designated attendance area is determined by their residence, in accordance with Colorado law. The designated attendance area determines the student's neighborhood school. The Board of Education is responsible for approving all school attendance areas. The superintendent will recommend any proposed changes to attendance areas to the Board based on geography and student population projections. The superintendent, in consultation with the Board, will determine whether to may form a committee to review school attendance areas prior to a recommendation.~~

- ~~• In establishing school boundaries, consideration shall be given to The the densities of students in an area in relation to the relative capacities of the schools, the equalization of enrollments in classrooms, choice/open enrollments, and efficient use of transportation resources.~~

District ~~staff shall~~will review enrollment trends on a regular basis and recommend attendance area/boundary adjustments as needed. In establishing or adjusting school boundaries, the superintendent and/or committee will use District guidelines on building capacities, as well as other relevant data, ~~will be used in the planning and review process. District staff shall provide for and obtain community and staff feedback on proposed boundary changes, that may include the formation of a committee. A summary of the feedback along with the recommendations. Consideration will be provided given to the Board. The Board is responsible for approving school attendance areas.~~

- the densities of students in an area in relation to the relative capacities of the schools.
- the equalization of enrollments in classrooms.
- choice/open enrollments, and
- efficient use of transportation resources.

~~The designated attendance area of a student shall be based on the student's residence as determined by application of Colorado law.~~

The District will provide for and obtain community and employee feedback on proposed boundary changes. The Board will receive a summary of the feedback along with the boundary recommendations.
