V.a. Transportation

V.b. Overnight Travel

Participation in the Sport may include in-state day and overnight travel and out-of-state overnight travel for regular and post-season Athletic Events that are usual and customary to the Sport. In submitting this Registration, it is assumed the Student will be participating in all in-state day and overnight travel associated with the Sport unless communicated in writing otherwise. For purposes of this Section V, in-state travel includes Laramie and Cheyenne, Wyoming.

A separate release, indemnity and assumption of risk is required for all out-of-state travel and all other in-state, overnight travel that occurs outside of the Sport's CHSAA season identified on the CHSAA calendar, which can be found at [CHSAA](#) under the "Info" tab.

Student and Parent(s) acknowledge and understand that the District shall have the authority to cancel or terminate travel and related on-site activities in accordance with its policies or best judgment. Furthermore, the Student and Parent(s) understand and agree that if the Student is injured or becomes ill during any travel and it is necessary for the Student to return home or for the Parent(s) to meet the Student to escort them home, the Parent(s) may be required to pay all costs.

Section VII: High School Athletic Participation Release, Indemnity, and Assumption of Risk

This High School Athletic Participation Release, Indemnity, and Assumption of Risk is given by the Students and the Parent(s), in favor of the District. Parent(s) also agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the District and its board members, employees, volunteers, and agents from and against any and all claims, liabilities and causes of action, including attorney fees and costs, for injury to the Student and/or for damages to or destruction of property belonging to the Student or Parent(s), which may arise out of or in connection with the Student's participation in the Sport.

Student and Parent(s) release and hold harmless the District and its board members, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all liability claims, causes of action, damages and demands of any kind whatsoever (except willful and wanton acts of omissions) that the Student, the Parent(s), or both, may have against the District and its board members, employee, volunteers, or agents for any and all damages, including personal injury to the Student, that may arise out of or in connection with the Sport.

By its nature, participation in athletics includes certain risks and dangers particular to the Sport, including the risk of injury ranging in severity from minor to catastrophic and long-term. Student and Parent(s) acknowledge and understand the risks and dangers that may exist in allowing the Student to participate in the Sport, assume the risk of any and all damages, including personal injury, which the Student may incur as a result of participating in the Sport and that, while the District seeks to do what is reasonable to ensure that participants in the Sport are safe and protected, the District cannot guarantee the Student's safety, and expressly disclaims any representation or undertaking that the activities associated with participation in the Sport are safe for the Student and further disclaims any and all liability or responsibility for illness, infection, or exposure to communicable disease that may occur from or in connection with the Sport.
