Tavelli's GT Program:

- Tavelli's Gifted and Talented program believes in the importance of building the academic and social/emotional needs of all students through various enrichment experiences in and out of the classroom.

- Acknowledges strengths and interests and helps the student build on them in an interdisciplinary approach.

Advanced Learning Plan process at this school



The ALP is written collaboratively between the GT teacher and the student. This ALP is then sent home for further conversation and updates with parents. Each identified student will have a goal that addresses both their area of identification and social/emotional (affective) needs. When appropriate, goals can be combined to better serve the student.

Affective programming for GT students



The Gifted and Talented Program at Tavelli Elementary School recognizes the GT student's affective characteristics and provides individual support through the school counselor, school psychologist, the GT teacher, and grade level teachers. The GT Program provides opportunities for students to discuss struggles and achievements in a safe environment with a trusted adult and/or other GT students with similar needs.

Grade-specific GT services
