Identified students participate twice a week in a pull-out enrichment time with the GT Site Coordinator tailored towards individual learning styles, strengths, and interests. Students go during the individual grade level's scheduled intervention/enrichment (WIN) blocks when no new material is being taught. During this time, the students work on book studies, research projects, higher level thinking skills, creative problem solving and other creative activities with a math or language arts focus. Students also work on social/emotional development. It is during this pull-out time that students will focus on their goals for their advanced learning plans (ALPs). Students will have work from the program to work on and complete during the remaining three days of their WIN time in class. Classroom teachers will differentiate for these students in the classroom throughout the day.

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Overview of the GT program at this school



Riffenburgh's GT Program:

Students who are identified as gifted participate twice a week in a pull-out enrichment time with the GT Site Coordinator tailored towards individual learning styles, strengths, and interests. Students go during the individual grade level's scheduled intervention/enrichment (WIN) blocks when no new material is being taught. During this time, the students work on book studies, research projects, higher level thinking skills, creative problem solving and other creative activities with a math or language arts focus. They will be provided with advanced learning experiences with appropriately higher learning standards. Student's strengths and interests will be acknowledged and students will build on them to branch out in an interdisciplinary approach. Learning is also taught through an International Baccalaureate (IB) lens.

Students also are taught social emotional skills and the GT teacher is available for any social/emotional support students may need. It is during WIN times, students will focus on their goals for their advanced learning plans (ALPs). Students will have work from the GT teacher to work on and complete during the remaining three days of their WIN time in class. Classroom teachers will also differentiate for these students in the classroom.

Advanced Learning Plan process at this school



Students work with the GT Site Coordinator to create ALP goals for the year and reflect on them in the middle of the year and at the end of the school year. Students choose their own goals and evaluate themselves on their selected goals. These goals are a combined academic and social/emotional goal.
