

Brain Injury Resource Team

PSD's Brain Injury Resource Team (BIRT) is a group of school psychologists, speech language pathologists, occupational therapists, special educators, nurses, parents and members from community agencies (HCP, DHS) with interest and expertise in the area of traumatic brain injuries. The role of the team is to provide consultation, training, and resources on brain injury to school teams, staff, and parents in support of students with acquired brain injury (damage to the brain which occurs after birth and is not related to a congenital or degenerative disease – it is classified as traumatic or non-traumatic).
