Poudre School District (PSD) Unified Sports is a program in which students with and without intellectual disabilities participate in inclusive school sports. Part of the mission for students with disabilities in PSD is for our students to realize meaningful outcomes in an inclusive and collaborative environment. Unified Sports is a program that helps to support that mission.

Our current sports at the high school level include cheerleading and flag football in the fall, cheerleading and basketball in the winter, and soccer in the spring. Middle school sports include basketball in the winter/spring season. K-12 student athletes and partners can also participate in a track and field event each May.

Unified Sports in PSD is a collaborative partnership between Special Olympics Colorado, Poudre School District, PSD Athletics, and Integrated Services.
