

JC - SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Attendance areas for each District elementary, middle and high school shall be approved by the superintendent, based on geography and student population projections.

In establishing school boundaries, consideration shall be given to the densities of students in an area in relation to the relative capacities of the schools, the equalization of enrollments in classrooms, choice/open enrollments, and efficient use of transportation facilities.

Enrollment trends shall be reviewed on a regular basis and if attendance area/boundary adjustments are needed, a committee review process shall be established. Attendance area/boundary committees shall include but not be limited to principals, assistant principals, teachers, classified employees and parent/community representatives. Such committees shall analyze and discuss potential boundary modifications, and present their recommendations (if any) to the superintendent.

The designated attendance area of a student shall be based on the student's residence as determined by application of Colorado law.
